On August 17, 2020 the City Council approved Ordinance No. 2020-O-100 ordering a Special Election to be held on November 03, 2020 to submit to voters of the City of Laredo, 8 proposed propositions; and designating polling places; providing for publications; and authorizing the City Manager to enter into a contract with Webb County Elections Administrator for the purpose of conducting a joint election.

RESOLUTION 2020-R-187

Canvassing the returns of the General and Special Election of the City of Laredo held on Tuesday, November 3, 2020 for: the Election of City Officials; a Special Election for proposed propositions (Charter Amendments); approving the results and ordering a runoff election; authorizing the City Manager to enter into contract with the Webb County Elections Administrator for the purpose of conducting a joint election with Laredo College (LC); designating a runoff date; and providing for publication and any other matters relating thereto.

WHERE AS, by Ordinance No. 2020-O-096 and Ordinance No. 2020-O-100, Ordering a General City Election concurrent with the General Election on Tuesday, November 03, 2020 for: the Election of City Officials and a Special Election for the submission of proposed propositions A through H; designating polling places; designating a runoff date; providing for publication; and, authorizing the City Manager to enter into contract with the Webb County Elections Administrator for the purpose of conducting a Joint Election with the City of Laredo and other matters relating thereto;

WHERE AS, by Ordinance No. 2020-O-096 approved on August 03, 2020, the Council ordered a General Election to be held on November 03, 2020 to elect the following City Officials:

COUNCIL MEMBERS FOR DISTRICTS: IV, V, VII, AND VIII

WHERE AS, by Ordinance No. 2020-O-100 approved on August 17, 2020, the Council ordered a Special Election to be held on November 03, 2020 to submit to the voters of the City of Laredo, 8 proposed propositions; and

WHERE AS, said City Council has investigated all matters pertaining to said election, including ordering, giving notice, and the election of officers holding and making return of said election; and

WHERE AS, the City Council hereby officially found and determined that said meeting was open to the public, and public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given, all in accordance with the Election Code and the ordinance calling said election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAREDO THAT:

Section 1: The City Council finds and determines that said elections were duly called and ordered; that proper notice was duly given; that proper election officers were duly appointed prior to said election; that said elections were duly held; that due returns of the results of said elections were made and delivered to the City of Laredo in accordance with the Election Code; the order calling said General Election, and Special Elections was issued by the Laredo City Council; and, that the City Council has duly canvassed said returns, all in accordance with the law and Ordinance calling said elections.

Section 2: The City Council officially finds and determines that the votes in the official tabulation results attached hereto were cast at said elections for the candidates and on the submitted PROPOSITIONS by qualified electors of the City of Laredo.

Section 3: The official returns attached hereto of said general election and special election are hereby approved and declared to be in due form as required by law, and that the candidates shown therein receiving a majority of the votes for their respective office, and that said successful candidates are entitled to fill the respective office by qualifying therefore as required by law and that those respective offices where no candidate receives a majority vote then the two candidates receiving the highest and second highest number of votes shall be the successful candidates to participate in a runoff election.

Section 4: That the City Council officially finds, determines and declares the result of said election to be that the PROPOSITIONS A through H, so submitted have received a favorable majority vote and have carried and effective from this date.

Section 5: There shall be a runoff election between the two candidates who received the highest and second highest number of votes in said general election, namely:
Nelly Vielma and Ruben Gutierrez Jr. for the position of City Council District V; Vanessa Perez and Betty Flores for the position of City Council District VII; Roberto Balli and Alyssa Cigarroa for the position of City Council District VIII;

Section 6: A runoff election is hereby ordered to be held and conducted within and for the City of Laredo on Saturday, December 12, 2020 for: City Council District: V, VII, VIII (not earlier than the 20th day and not later than the 45th day after the date the final canvass of the main election was completed).

Section 7: The candidates for said runoff election are Nelly Vielma and Ruben Gutierrez Jr. for the position of City Council District V; Vanessa Perez and Betty Flores for the position of City Council District VII; Roberto Balli and Alyssa Cigarroa for the position of City Council District VIII; and the order in which their names will appear on the ballot shall be determined by Election law manuel section 14.07 (c) Order of names on the ballot. The order of the candidates' names on the runoff ballot is the same as the relative order of the names on the original ballot in the main election [Ec 52.094, as amended by HB 88 and see M 8.06].

Section 8: The polls at each designated polling place on said runoff election, as set forth in "Exhibit G" which is attached hereto and made part of this resolution for all purposes, on said day shall be open from 7:00 o'clock a.m. to 7:00 o'clock p.m.

Section 9: That the Presiding Judges shall appoint not less than two qualified election clerks to serve and assist in conducting said election; provided that if the Presiding Judge actually serves as expected, the Alternate Presiding Judge shall be one of such clerks.

Section 10: That the period for early voting by personal appearance shall begin on November 30, 2020 and shall continue through the fourth day preceding the date of the election, December 08, 2020. The main polling place for early voting shall be the Webb County Justice Center, located at 1100 Washington St., Laredo Texas and such other early voting as identified in attached "Exhibit F". The main early voting site and the permanent branch early voting sites shall remain open as identified in attached "Exhibit F". The designated polling places shall not be open on Saturday's, Sundays or official holidays, except as otherwise provided for in schedule of "Exhibit F".

Section 11: That the Early Voting Clerk for said election shall be appointed by the Webb County Elections Administrator.

Section 12: Application for ballots by mail shall be conducted by the Webb County Elections Administrator. All ballot applications and ballots voted by mail shall be sent to the Webb County Elections Administrator, 1110 Washington, St., Suite 103, P.O. Box 29, Laredo, Texas 78042-029.

Section 13: That notice of said election shall be given by posting a substantial copy of this ordinance at City Hall on the bulletin board used for posting notices of the meetings of the City Council, and a substantial copy of this ordinance also shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in said City in accordance with the Texas Election Code.

Section 14: That said election shall be conducted at each designated voting place and the ballot to be used at such election be printed in the form required by the Texas Election Code and manufacturer's specifications with names of candidates and propositions printed thereon in full and prepared in such manner as specified by the Texas Elections Code. That this election is to be conducted utilizing Election Systems and Software's ("ES&S") iVotronic Direct Record Electronic ("DRE") voting system to be used at each and every early voting and election day polling site in conjunction with the existing electronic ("Optical Scan") voting system which utilizes three (3) M650 Central Scanners to tabulate and count said ballots and one (1) Election Reporting Manager ("E.R.M") to accumulate results from both electronic systems currently owned and operated by the County of Webb in the conduct of elections, for its Joint Special Elections to be held Saturday, December 12, 2020.

Section 15: That immediately after the votes at such Runoff Election have been conducted and proper returns thereof made to the City Council, said City Council shall meet to canvass the runoff election returns as required by the election code and cause to be entered in the proper records of the City of Laredo, Texas, its official declaration of, or order showing the actual and true results of said general and special election regarding city charter amendment propositions election.

Section 16: That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract agreement with the Webb County Elections Administrator to conduct said Runoff

Election and accept the terms and conditions as set forth in the contract attached hereto and identified as
"Exhibit B".

**ELECTION SERVICES CONTRACT
WITH COUNTY ELECTIONS ADMINISTRATOR
COUNTY OF WEBB, STATE OF TEXAS**

THIS CONTRACT made on this 12th day of November, 2020, by and between the **City Council of Laredo (through the City Secretary)**, hereinafter referred to as "Party," and Jose Salvador Tellez, County Elections Administrator for Webb County, Texas, hereinafter referred to as "Contracting Officer", and by authority of sections 31.092(a) and 271.002, Texas Election Code, for the conduct and supervision of the **Joint Runoff Elections of December 12, 2020**.

THIS CONTRACT is subject to the written approval of the political subdivision involved in the election, and shall not be binding on the party until such written approval is obtained. An estimate for services to be rendered pursuant to the terms of the contract provided by the Contracting Officer are attached herewith and labeled exhibits A thru G. It is agreed that it is in the public interest of the **City Council of Laredo**, being one of several entities participating in this election that Jose Salvador Tellez, Elections Administrator, serve as the Early Voting Clerk for all entities participating in this election.

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into in consideration of the mutual covenants and promises hereinafter set out:

DUTIES AND SERVICES OF CONTRACTING OFFICER. The Contracting Officer shall be responsible for performing the following duties and shall furnish the following services and equipment:

- (a) Contact the owners or custodians of county-designated polling places and arrange for their use in the election.
- (b) Contact the owner or custodian of some other public place (or if unavailable, private) building in the election precinct and arrange for its use as a polling place if the county designated polling place in the precinct is unavailable for use in the election.
- (c) Procure, prepare, and distribute all necessary election supplies, including:
 - (1) ballots;
 - (2) election kits,
 - (3) ballot boxes and voting booths, and
 - (4) all necessary ADA compliant iVotronic voting machines and equipment.
- (d) Notify election judges of the date, time, and place of any election school
- (e) Arrange for the use of a central counting station and for the tabulating personnel and equipment needed at the counting station and assist in the preparation of programs and test materials for the tabulation of the ballots to be used with electronic voting equipment.
- (f) Publish the legal notices of the date, time, and place of the test of the electronic tabulating equipment and conduct such test.
- (g) Assist in the general overall supervision of the election and provide advisory services in connection with the decisions to be made and the actions to be taken by the officers who are responsible for holding the election.
- (h) Prepare any submission of voting changes to the U.S. Department of Justice under the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- (a) Nothing contained in this contract shall authorize or permit a change in the officer with whom or the place at which any document or record relating to the election is to be filed, the place at which any function is to be carried out, the officers who conduct the official canvass of the election returns, the officer to serve as custodian of the voted ballots or other election records, or any other nontransferable functions specified by section 31.096 of the Texas Election Code.

- (b) The Contracting Officer is the agent of the Entity for the purposes of contacting the third parties with respect to the election expenses within the scope of the Contracting Officer's duties, and the Contracting Officer is not liable for the Entities' failure to pay a claim.
- (c) The Contracting Officer shall file copies of this contract with the County Treasurer and the County Auditor of Webb County, Texas.
- (d) Only the actual expenses directly attributable to the Contract may be charged (Section 31.100(b), Texas Election Code). The County Elections Officer must submit the actual costs incurred pursuant to this Contract to the Governmental Entity within a reasonable amount of time after the election.

COST OF SERVICES

- (a) In consideration for the services provided by the Contracting Officer, the Party agrees to pay Webb County their share of the cost of the **December 12, 2020 Joint Runoff Elections** in accordance with the following schedule:

GENERAL PROVISIONS

- (a) This contract shall be construed under and in accordance with applicable Federal and State laws, and all obligations of the parties created hereunder are performable in Webb County, Texas.
- (b) In case any one or more of the provisions contained in this contract shall for any reason be held to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable in any respect, such invalidity, illegality, or unenforceability shall not affect any other provision thereof, and this contract shall be construed as if such invalid, illegal, or unenforceable provision had never been contained herein.
- (c) It is understood that in the case of an election contest solely challenging this Party's election results, the cost of such contest, challenge, or litigation will be borne by the Party.
- (d) It is further understood that in the case of a runoff election due to undecided races on the election, the cost of such runoff election will also be borne by the Party and will be contracted for at such time.
- (e) It is also further understood that in a joint election all participating parties share in the cost of such joint election. If one or more parties withdraw, has unopposed candidates, or has circumstances which change the precincts or districts involved in the election, the cost to the other parties will be affected and will consequently be adjusted.

- (f) This contract constitutes the sole and only agreement of the parties hereto and supersedes any prior understanding of written or oral agreement between the parties respecting the written subject matter.
- (g) No amendment, modification, or alteration of the terms hereof shall be binding unless the same is in writing, dated subsequent to the date hereof, and duly executed by the parties hereof.


